Boys and Girls Program Information

Acceptance Policy:

To protect existing campers and their families, we accept only returning applicants and their siblings until October 15th; then, prior year wait-listed and returning campers until October 31st; then everyone else based on the date we receive the application and deposit. All prior balances must be paid in full before an application for 2010 will be processed.

Spaces will not be saved without a completed application and deposit.

Payment Policy and Procedures:

Checks drawn on foreign banks are extremely expensive and time consuming to process. Therefore, we would appreciate receiving payment by one of the following options:

Except for the deposit, Visa or MasterCard is discouraged due to the high transaction cost. A bill for the remaining tuition charges will be sent out in February. **Final payment must be received by March 15.**

Refund Policy:

Once a child is admitted, the \$750 Deposit is non-refundable. Tuition payments are also non-refundable, but in special circumstances please contact the Director.

If you are mailing a set of keys or the lock combination to camp, please write: ATTN: Faye on the package (for Kieve) or ATTN: Jean (for Wavus).

Please keep in mind when sending anything overnight: we are considered rural, and even though "Express" is a one-day service, for us it will be a two-day service. And it is important to use a service with tracking so that lost baggage can be traced.

Transportation Information:

For campers arriving from East Coast locations from Philadelphia north, Kieve-Wavus provides charter bus transportation to camp at a pro-rated charge per camper. Depending on numbers, we may use vans for the Boston area campers and for the introductory sessions. The busses and vans make stops near Philadelphia, Princeton, NJ, the New York City area, Darien, CT, Hartford, CT. and the Boston area.

The camp will supply you with suggested flight information after your application has been accepted. When the option exists, it is preferable that your child fly into Portland, ME, but Boston's Logan Airport and the Manchester, NH Airport are other options. The cost of ground transportation to and from the airport is pro-rated and will be billed to you at the end of camp.

At the conclusion of camp, we can transport campers to the airports on Saturday.

If there are any changes to your child's transportation to and from camp, please email camp to confirm.

Tipping Policy:

It is the Board's policy not to allow tipping.

Annual Fund:

In the Fall we will send you a letter requesting help with our non-profit mission. We hope you will be especially generous so that we can continue to help thousands of neighboring children less fortunate than we are through our Leadership School programs, offer camp scholarships to children without financial means, and operate our family camp for survivors of the September 11 attacks.

We have a number of clothing and other items available for sale through our web site (www.kieve.org).

Parents' Day:

Most parents attend the Parents' Day ceremonies at the end of each session. There are a very limited number of accommodations available on site for Parents' Weekends.

If these are not available, we will be happy to send you a list of accommodations in the surrounding area; this list can also be found on our website. We strongly recommend that you make reservations as soon as possible.

Clothing and Equipment:

After your application has been accepted, you will receive a list of clothing and equipment your son or daughter should bring with them to camp. This list will differ depending on your child's age and the trips they will be taking. Most items are available in your local Army/Navy or sporting goods store, Amerasport and LL Bean. We will provide websites in the Spring emailing.

Good camping equipment is important for all of our trips; it is especially important for the longer expeditions, including Allagash, Long Voyage, and Maine Trails. A detailed list of necessary equipment will be provided to parents of campers going on one of these trips. All clothing and

equipment should be clearly marked so that it goes home with the same camper who brought it. Don't overpack. (Boys tend to wear the same things over and over until they turn to dust.) We are very informal, so send clothes that your son or daughter is outgrowing or that doesn't have much wear left in them. They will be expected to wear a Kieve or Wavus shirt on Sundays.

If your son or daughter owns a PFD (personal flotation device), please send it with them to camp.

Bedding:

While in camp, the campers sleep on bunks (twin-sized) with sheets and blankets, not in their sleeping bags. Your son or daughter will want to bring their favorite pillow and bedding along with them.

Cabin Assignment:

On the application there is the opportunity to indicate other campers your child would like to bunk with. The Directors will take these preferences into consideration when making the final cabin assignments. A list of your child's cabin mates and counselors will be sent to you shortly before camp begins.

Wilderness Trips:

Every camper goes on at least one camping trip with their cabin. The older the camper, the longer the trip. Please see our brochure or web site for a further description of this important aspect of a Kieve-Wavus education.

Telephone/Email:

Except in special circumstances, telephone calls between campers and parents are not allowed since they often cause potential homesickness to surface. Parents can also reach their children via email through the Camper Connection. More information is available in the Spring emailing.

For many reasons, practical as well as philosophical, we prefer families to rely on the U.S. Mail.

Visitors:

Parents and friends are welcome to visit Kieve or Wavus any time after the first 10 days of the session. Please call first to ensure that your child is not on a day or overnight trip away from camp or working through homesickness. Most parents wait to visit until Parents' Day at the end of the session.
