Lost & found: Unclaimed clothing, etc. is on the porch of Pasquaney. Items left behind will be mailed home if they are labeled and don't smell too nasty. **Please check the lost & found items before you leave.**

"Thistles & Things Store": Shirts, hats, belts, and other Kieve items are for sale at the administrative office half way up the hill. You can charge stuff and we'll include it in your son's final billing. Lots more is available at www.kieve.org.

Luggage to be sent home: If you would like us to ship your son's stuff please fill out the address labels that are on the porch on the driveway side of Innisfree. The UPS charge will be included in your final billing. **Before closing your luggage, you should place another address label inside with the same information just in case the outside label is torn off. It is also highly recommended that you tape the address on the outside.** Please leave addressed luggage on Innisfree porch and we will see that it is sent out on Monday morning. We suggest you open it immediately upon returning home to prevent mildew and strange growths from consuming your pristine home.

2012 Application Policy: Our enrollment fills very quickly. Returning boys and their siblings receive priority acceptance **Prior to October 15th**. Our **online application** is new this year, so please go to our web site (www.kieve.org) and complete the application form at your earliest convenience if he wants to return. **(Please keep in mind that we have alumni from both camps now and their siblings will also be accepted right away, thus we will fill up quicker than ever!)** We are not printing 2012 applications again this year as we are going "green". A report of your son's activities a week or two after camp ends will be mailed out to you. If your son has friends interested in joining him next year, please direct them to the online application available at www.kieve.org.
