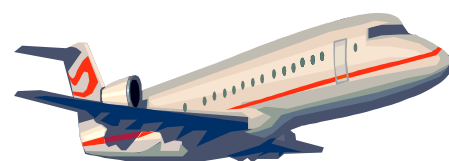

COMMERCIAL AIR TRAVEL

Please have your child leave their Walkman, Gameboy, *etc.* at home. These devices tend to encourage children to “tune out” rather than interact with their peers. Also, please DO NOT allow your child to bring a cellular phone or other handheld communication device with them to camp. These are not appropriate during the camp session. On the plane ride, we suggest they bring a book to occupy their time or a headset to listen to the music or movie offered on the flight.

Kieve or Wavus Staff will meet campers at the following airports on opening day:

- **Portland, Maine** (Approximately 60 miles away)
- **Manchester, New Hampshire** (Approximately 150 miles away)
- **Boston, Massachusetts** (Approximately 180 miles away)



Please **try to schedule arrivals between noon and 3:00 p.m.** if possible. We understand that flights from the west coast and Europe will most likely be a little later.

The Portland, Maine airport is the closest, easiest airport for us. For all airports, your child will be met by one of our staff members wearing a Kieve or Wavus shirt just outside the secured area on the way to baggage claim, or for international arrivals just outside the U.S. Customs doors. Please also have your child wear a Kieve or Wavus shirt or hat for easy identification.

The cost of ground transportation from the airport to Kieve or Wavus is pro-rated and will be billed to you at the end of camp. If your child will be traveling as an **unaccompanied minor**, please tell Faye at Kieve or Jean at Wavus, so that they can tell you the name of the counselor picking your child up at the airport.

Please complete and return to us **by April 1st for First and Intro 1 Sessions and by June 1st for Second and Intro 2 Sessions**, the Travel Form indicating how your child will travel to Kieve or Wavus. If your child will be returning home by air after camp on Saturday, we can take them to Portland, Boston or Manchester airports. Please try to schedule flight out of Portland from 10:00 a.m. on **(1-hour ride to airport)** and from Boston and Manchester from 12:00 p.m. on **(3-hour ride to airport)**.
