



Kieve–Wavus Bus Travel Instructions 2012

Kieve-Wavus will provide transportation to camp on Opening Day at a pro-rated cost per camper from the following locations and times below. The chartered buses say “Cyr Bus Lines” on the side. Depending on our numbers, we may use vans for the Boston area boys. Henry Kennedy will chaperone for Kieve and a Wavus staff person will chaperone for Wavus for the First and Second Session pick-ups. Other staff members will handle the Introductory Sessions and we will be using 17-passenger vans for those pick-ups. If your child is coming on the bus, please provide a lunch (if they are on one of the earlier stops) and a few dollars (or coins for the soda machine) for incidentals along the way.

Please have your child leave their Walkman, Gameboy, *etc.* at home. These devices tend to encourage children to “tune out” rather than interact with their peers. Also, please DO NOT allow your child to bring a cellular phone or other handheld communication device with them to camp. These are not appropriate during the camp session. On the bus ride there are movies and hilarious Camp Directors to keep them occupied on the way to camp. We need the room on the bus for campers and since space is very limited under the bus, ***please be sure to ship all luggage ahead*** (otherwise we would need an additional bus for just the luggage).

The following are the bus **departure** times from each stop ~ please arrive **at least 15 minutes ahead of time.**

Stop #1 Philadelphia area – 7:20 a.m. – parking lot of the Plymouth Meeting Mall. The Mall is near the Junction of Route 476 and **Exit 333 (formerly Exit 25)** (Norristown exit) of the Pennsylvania Turnpike. We’ll be in front of Macy’s Department Store, on west side of the mall. **approximately 10 hrs. 30 min. to camp**

Stop #2 Princeton area – 8:15 a. m. – Woodrow Wilson Service Area between **Exits 7 and 7A** on the **Northbound** side of the N.J. Turnpike. **Park up top with the cars.**
Note: you must get to the Northbound side of the turnpike – please get there on time!
approximately 9 hrs. 45 min. to camp

Stop #3 Summit, N.J. & New York City Area – 9:40 a.m. – Vince Lombardi Service Area of the New Jersey Turnpike, (bus parking area) Ridgefield, N.J. If you are heading **North** the Vince Lombardi Service Area is approximately two miles north of **Exit 18W**. If you are heading **South** from the George Washington Bridge it is approximately four miles after you go over the bridge.
Important – please park in the car parking area, then walk to the bus parking area to meet the bus.
approximately 8 hrs. 20 min. to camp

Stop #4 Connecticut & alternative for New York City area – 11:00 a.m. – McDonald’s in the all-service area on the New England Thruway (**I-95**) in **Darien, CT (between Exits 12 & 13).**
Important – Park in front of the restaurant but meet the bus behind the restaurant in the bus/truck parking area.
approximately 6 hrs. to camp

Stop #5 Hartford area – 12:30 p.m. – Crowne Plaza Hotel at Cromwell, Connecticut – Exit 21 off 91 North – just after leaving Highway 91 at the Cromwell exit, take left, and the Crowne Plaza is on the left.
Important- Note that hotels change names often, so it may be something different come summer...
approximately 5 hrs. 30 min. to camp

Stop #6 Boston area – 2:45 p.m. – McDonald’s at the **Exit 30 rest area** on the northbound side of **Route 128** (just north of **Route 2 Exit** in **Lexington**). *The rest area is off the exit ramp.*
approximately 3 hrs. 30 min. to camp
